



## **Coosa River Campground at Lock and Dam Park** **A facility of the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority**

All RV Sites have electrical and water hookups, grills or fire rings, and picnic tables. Select sites feature sewer hook-ups, river views and pavilions. A dump station is available for all registered campers. A bath house, laundry facilities, boat ramp, walking trails, playground and fishing are conveniently located throughout the park. Also for your convenience the Coosa River Trading Post has a large selection of fishing and camping supplies.

**Park Hours:** Dawn to Dusk

**Coosa River Trading Post Hours are subject to seasonal change.**

**Caretaker:** For any afterhours problems or disturbances contact the Caretaker at the residence next to the Trading Post.

**Site Specific Reservations:** Campsite reservations are for a “type of site,” not for a specific campsite number. All requests will be processed on a first come first serve basis for registered campers only.

**Group Reservations:** Group Discounts are available. Pavilion and Meeting Room are available for reservation for an additional fee.

**Minimum Stay:** A two-night minimum is required for weekend reservations, and a three-night minimum is required for Memorial Day, Labor Day and Independence Day weekends.

**Deposits and Cancellations:** A non – refundable deposit equal to one night stay is required. Cancellations made at least three days prior to the arrival date will receive a credit. Campers must pay the full balance upon check-in. No credits are given when the stay is shortened to less than the required minimum. Reservations may be transferred **once** to another date without penalty as long as it is made at least three days prior to the arrival date. To cancel or change a reservation, call 706.234.5001.

**Occupancy:** To protect park resources, campsite occupancy is limited to one of the following combinations:

- One motor home with two additional automobiles.
- One automobile with pop-up trailer/travel trailer and one additional automobile.
- One pickup truck with mounted camping rig and two additional automobiles.
- Two tents and two automobiles.
- Note: One boat trailer is allowed at each site provided that the site is large enough. Boat trailers can be left in the parking lot at no additional cost provided the maximum campsite occupancy limit is not exceeded.

Campsites have a six-person occupancy limit, and tents must fit on designated tent pads. Tents erected off designated tent pads are subject to removal. Camping between designated sites is prohibited. When camping areas are filled to stated capacity, no other campers will be allowed. Camping is limited to 14 consecutive days. Visitors using a campsite for 14 nights must vacate the park for at least four nights before returning.

**Check-In:** Check-in is between 3 p.m. and 8 p.m. and check-out is 11 a.m. Campers must register and pay remaining balance before setting up. Both the reservation and deposit fee are forfeited if the camper does not check in by 8 p.m. on the scheduled arrival date. Tents and other personal property left overnight in an unoccupied campsite are subject to removal and fees will be forfeited. “Saving” sites for late-arriving guests is allowed only for reservations made in advance, but cannot be monitored by park staff.

**Severe Weather:** In the event of severe weather, the Caretaker will make available the Trading Post Basement at the west end of the Store for shelter.

**Rules:**

*Rules for the Coosa River Campground have been developed for the benefit and safety of park visitors. If you have questions or concerns please see the Trading Post store attendant or Caretaker.*

**Parking:** The Daily User Fee for Parking is \$2 and \$3 for Boat Launch. The daily fees are waived for registered campers. Campers should display their receipt on the left side of their windshield or dashboard. Any vehicle left unattended in the park after dusk without a pass may be impounded at the owners’ expense.

**Pets:** Pets are welcome in campgrounds if kept on a six-foot leash and attended at all times. Kennels are not available. Owners should clean up after pets.

**Intoxicants:** Consumption or use of alcoholic beverages or intoxicants is unlawful in any public-use area.

**Campfires:** All campfires must be kept in designated areas such as a fire ring. Never leave a campfire unattended. Tree cutting is not allowed.

**Food:** Hungry animals can be very clever and destructive, so don’t leave coolers or food out at an unoccupied campsite. Keep food locked in vehicles or tied high on a tree branch.

**Bath House:** The Bath House is for registered campers. Dishwashing is not allowed.

**Weapons:** Concealed firearms, bows and arrows, explosives, fireworks, slingshots, fishing spears or any device that discharges projectiles by any means is prohibited.

**Collecting:** All wildlife, plant life, driftwood, artifacts and any other natural or man-made features are protected and may not be disturbed or removed. Please leave wildflowers for other visitors to enjoy.

**Motor Vehicles:** Park roads are public roads. All vehicles are subject to license safety requirements and regulations of the Georgia Department of Public Safety. **ATVs are not allowed.**

**Noise Levels:** Please be considerate of guests who are visiting state parks for a quiet, natural experience. Radios, televisions, musical instruments and all other noise-making devices are not to be used between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. and must be kept at low volumes during other times.

**Failure to abide by campground rules may result in removal from the park and forfeiture of all fees paid.**
