The Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority (RFPRA) is requesting written quotes from qualified firms to provide an aerial Fireworks Display at Ridge Ferry Park, 282 Riverside Parkway, Rome, GA 30165 on Wednesday July 4, 2012.

All quotes are to be **FOB destination** to include cost of required insurance, permits, license, materials, electronic firing system, staff, transportation, set up and clean up.

Scope of Work: Two quotes are requested: (1) \$10,000 aerial fireworks display and (2) \$15,000 aerial fireworks display. Quotes should not exceed requested amounts and should include the following:

- Fully trained technicians to install produce and dismantle a safe display; including clean up and dud search.
- Any transportation and delivery cost.
- All materials including shells electronic firing system.
- Shells quoted should be three (3) to five (5) inches in size only, smaller or larger will not be accepted.
- A detailed list of all proposed shells, quantity and unit cost for the opening, main and grand finale displays. Special effects attached to shells should be listed separately.

- Required Insurance: \$1 million general liability; \$1 million automobile liability and workers compensation, naming Rome-Floyd Parks & Recreation Authority as an additional insured. A copy of the certificate of liability insurance will be required prior to the event.
- Fully licensed by the US Bureau of Alcohol, Firearms & Explosives and the DOT including CDL and hazardous material endorsement.
- Copies all required permits from local, state and federal government must be submitted prior to the event.
- A detailed inclement weather policy.
- References are required from customers with similar budgets.
