After the time and in the Parks Headquarters Conference Room, the bids will be publicly opened and read. No extension of the bidding period will be made.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS
INVITATION TO BID**

1. CHANGES: No change will be made to this invitation except by written modification by the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority Purchasing Office. **Requests for interpretation or changes must be in writing** and received at least (5) Five Calendar Days prior to the time set for opening of the bids.

2. FOB POINT: Bid Price to include shipping, packing, crating, and unloading at address in BID SCHEDULE. Title to remain with vendor until fully accepted by the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority. Goods damaged or not meeting specifications will be rejected and removed at vendor's expense. Concealed damaged goods to remain the property of vendor until replaced or removed at Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority's direction.

3. RISK OF LOSS: Vendor agrees to bear all risk of loss, injury, and destruction of goods and materials ordered herein which occur prior to delivery to include concealed damage; and such loss, injury, or destruction shall not release vendor from any obligation.

4. BID ACCEPTANCE TIME: Bids requiring acceptance by the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority in less than Ninety (90) calendar days could be rejected, unless so stated on **BIDDER'S RESPONSE PAGE** and accepted by the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority.

5. BID IDENTIFICATION: All bids submitted as a result of this invitation must be returned in a sealed envelope with the following information in the lower left-hand corner of the envelope: **SEALED BID, SUPPLIER NAME, BID NAME, AND DATE AND TIME OF OPENING.**

6. WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS: Bids may be withdrawn by written request only, if the request is received prior to the time and date set for the opening of bids. Negligence on the part of the bidder in preparing his bid confers no right of withdrawal or modification of his bid after bid has been opened. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of Sixty (60) days after time has been called on the date of opening.

7. BONDS: Payment and Performance Bonds: 100% of the amount of the bid will be required by successful bidder. A 5% Bid Bond is also required.

Interested vendors will meet at the Rome-Floyd Tennis Center, located at 300 West Third Street, Rome, Georgia 30165, beside Barron Stadium (to the right). (If Applicable) Bidders should inspect the sites to ascertain the nature and location of work and the general conditions, which could affect the work or the cost thereof. The Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority will assume no responsibility for representations or understandings concerning conditions made by its officers or employees unless included in this Invitation for Bid. While site inspections are not a mandatory requirement to submit a proposal, vendors are urged to schedule inspections to ascertain all the requirements of this invitation.

9. AWARD OF CONTRACT: Award will be made to that responsible bidder whose bid, conforming to the Invitation for Bid, will be most advantageous to the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority; Price and other factors considered. The Recreation Authority reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids submitted and to waive any technicalities or minor irregularities in bids received. A written award, mailed (or otherwise furnished) shall be deemed to result in a binding contract without further action by either party. Contract (s), if awarded, will be on a lump sum basis **or** individual item basis, whichever is found to be in the best interest of Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority.

9.1: The vendor, in accepting this contract, attests that he is in compliance with the Nondiscrimination Clause contained in Section 202 of Executive Order 11246, as amended, relative to equal employment opportunity for all persons without regard to race, color, religion, sex, or national origin, and the implementing rules and prescribed by the Secretary of Labor, which is incorporated herein by reference.

10. EXCEPTIONS TO SPECIFICATIONS: Any award resulting from this invitation shall bind the bidder to all Terms, Conditions, and Specifications set forth in this invitation. Bidders whose bids do not conform should so note on separate page if necessary and/or on the **BID SCHEDULE**. While the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority reserves the right to make an award to a nonconforming bidder, when in the best interest of the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority, such awards will not be readily made, and bidders are urged to conform to the greatest extent possible. No exceptions will be considered to have been taken by bidder unless it is properly set out as provided above. No exception will be deemed to have been taken by the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority unless incorporated in an award resulting from this invitation and so stated.

12. PAYMENT: Payments will be made upon all items completed each month or completion of all work and acceptance by Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority on invoices submitted and approved by the proper Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority representative within (30) thirty days receipt of invoice unless paragraph 14 applies. Invoices received with any of the required information listed above missing may not be considered as a "correct invoice". All invoices submitted will be closely monitored for accuracy. Any invoice found to be incorrect will be returned to vendor for correction.

12.2 Vendor must furnish delivery receipt with invoice identifying that this order has been delivered in accordance with Specifications, Quantities, and Price as set forth on the purchase order. A Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority employee's signature must appear on the delivery receipt or invoice.

12.3 Items on this order are exempt from Federal Excise Tax and Georgia Sales and Use Tax. A certificate will be furnished if requested. Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority is exempt from taxes but the successful bidder shall pay all taxes required of him by law and Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority cannot exempt others from tax.

12.4 Payment terms and provisions herein or otherwise found within the contract documents supersede all provisions of the Georgia Prompt Pay Act (House Bill 837; 13 O.C.G.A. Chapter 11 **ET. SEQ.**).

13. INQUIRIES REGARDING PAYMENT: All inquiries regarding payment of invoices are to be directed to Accounts Payable, (706) 314-0730, Adonna Puckett – Floyd Co. Finance.

14. DISCOUNTS: Prompt payment discounts offered for a period of less than Fifteen (15) Days will not be considered in determining the low bidder on this invitation. However, such discounts, when offered, will be taken provided payment is made within the time specified. Time, in connection with discounts for prompt payments, will be computed from the date of acceptance of work for which payment is claimed, or the date the correct invoice is received by the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority, whichever is later.

15. EXECUTION OF CONTRACT: Subsequent to the award, the successful bidder will be presented with a contract. Contract is to be executed within Ten (10) calendar days of "**NOTICE OF AWARD**" together with the required payment and performance bonds prescribed in Paragraph 7B. If the contract document is mailed, the date of presentation shall be deemed to be the postmark date. The successful bidder's proposal and this Invitation for Bid shall be incorporated into the contract, except to the extent that this invitation conflicts with the contract, in which case the provisions of the contract shall take precedent.

16. CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE: Successful bidder shall secure and maintain in force throughout the duration of this contract comprehensive general liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$500,000 per occurrence and \$1,000,000 aggregate for personal injury and \$500,000 per occurrence/aggregate for property damage.

Said general liability policy shall name Rome-Floyd Parks & Recreation Authority as an additional named insured and shall include a provision prohibiting cancellation of said policy except upon 30 days prior written notice to the Owner. Certificates of coverage as required by this section shall be delivered to the Owner within 14 days of execution of contract.

17. INCLUSION: All items and/or services standard, expected, necessary, and/or routine to such a project as this and not actually stated in this Invitation for Bid will be the responsibility of the successful bidder to provide at no other cost to the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority unless so stated on the successful bidder's proposal as additional cost items and accepted by the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority at the time of the award and/or contract.

18. REGULATORY AGENCIES: Successful bidder will be responsible for all required permits or license required by regulatory agency of the City, County, State, or Federal Governments. Further, successful bidder will be responsible for meeting all requirements of any regulation(s) or guideline(s) of any of the said Governments or any independent agency recognized by said Governments as publisher of any such regulation(s) or guideline(s).

19. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS: The bidder represents to ROME-FLOYD PARKS AND RECREATION AUTHORITY that he is fully experienced and properly qualified to perform the functions provided herein and that he is properly equipped, organized, and financed to perform such functions. The bidder shall finance his own operations hereunder, shall operate as an independent contractor and not as an agent of ROME-FLOYD PARKS AND RECREATION AUTHORITY and nothing contained in this Invitation for Bid or a contract resulting from same shall be construed to constitute the bidder or any of his employees, servants, agents, or subcontractors as a partner, employee, servant, or agent of the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority nor shall either party have any authority to bind the other in any respect; it being intended that each shall remain an independent contractor.

20. ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACTUAL RIGHTS: It is agreed that the successful bidder will not assign, transfer, convey, or otherwise dispose of a contract that results from this invitation or his right, title, or interest in or to the same, or any part thereof, without written consent of the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority.

21. STARTING TIME: Work will commence within Ten (10) calendar days after being issued a "NOTICE TO PROCEED" on the project and commence in a routine, orderly manner until completion and acceptance by the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority.

22. INDEMNITY: Successful bidder agrees, if entering into a contract as a result of this invitation, to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless ROME-FLOYD PARKS AND RECREATION AUTHORITY from any and all courses of action or claims of damages arising out of or related to bidder's performance or actions or those of his employees or agents, under said contract.

23. TERMINATION: Pursuant to O.C.G.A. 36-60-13, if applicable, any contract resulting from this Invitation for Bid, if not sooner terminated pursuant to the provisions of termination contained herein, is terminable by the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority Board on December 31 of each calendar year during the term of said contract, except that said contract shall be renewed automatically on such date, and without any lapse, unless positive action is taken to terminate said contract by the Board in a public meeting and such action entered in the Official Minutes of the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority Board.

24. APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS: Initial contract and any continuation contract (s) will terminate immediately and absolutely at any such time as there are no appropriated and otherwise unobligated funds available to satisfy the Rome-Floyd Parks and Recreation Authority obligations under said contract(s).

25. CANCELLATION FOR CAUSE: Should either party fail to comply with the Terms and Conditions of this contract, the aggrieved party must give, in writing, to the other party any complaint for non compliance to the Terms and Conditions of this contract. The other party shall have Fifteen (15) calendar days to correct the matter. If corrected to the satisfaction of both parties within the Fifteen (15) calendar days and stated in writing, then the contract will continue uninterrupted. Failure to correct the matter will result in termination of this contract at the end of Thirty (30) calendar days following the date of the initial letter of complaint.

Tennis Court Re-Surfacing Scope of Work

SCOPE OF WORK:

Rome-Floyd Parks & Recreation Authority is making improvements to an existing park. This bid is for the re-surfacing of sixteen (16) tennis courts at the Rome-Floyd Tennis Center. Specifications are included as part of these bid documents.

ALL WORK IS TO BE COMPLETED BY MAY 4TH 2012.

Bidder to submit product samples, specifications, and documentation that product is equal to that which is specified.

Surfacing Requirements:

ITEM A:

Fill cracks with AcryTech crack filler.

Fill minor depressions with Acrylic Sport Patch materials

Apply one (1) coat of Acrylic Resurfacer

Apply two (2) coats of AcryTech with UV-15 Colorguard or equal

(Color of Dark Blue [US OPEN BLUE PMS 533C or 2955U] inside w/Green perimeter [US OPEN GREEN PMS 364U])

Stripe courts to the standard court line with textured line paint.

ITEM B:

All sixteen (16) tennis courts at the Rome-Floyd Tennis Center to be striped as sixty (60) foot courts in addition to the standard court lines. (Lighter Blue)

Scope of Work:

Surface Preparation –

1. Surface to be coated must be sound, free of loose dirt, dust, or other foreign matter.
2. Clean courts with a high pressure power washer. (3000 psi)
3. Clean, fill and smooth all cracks with an acrylic crack filler.

Patching Depressions –

1. Surface should be flooded with water and allowed to drain for (1) hour.
2. Any area that retains water deeper than the thickness of a nickel should be patched using an acrylic sport patch with the following mixing formula:

Acrylic Sport Patch	(3) gallons
Clean Silica Sand	(100) lbs.
Portland Cement	(1) gallon
3. The area behind the baseline that has been patched should be smoothed out with multiple coats of acrylic resurfacer and the edges feathered by use of an acrylic sport patch. Prior to the application of acrylic sport patch, the crack around the asphalt patch should be covered with fiberglass embedded acrylic resurfacer.

Acrylic Resurfacer –

1. In order to provide a tight, blemish free surface, (1) application of acrylic resurfacer shall be applied to the entire surface at a rate of .04-.05 gallons per square yard. Acrylic resurfacer is to be mixed as follows:

Acrylic Resurfacer	(27) gallons
Clean Silica Sand	(250) lbs.
Water	(15-18) gallons

Acrylic Color Coat –

1. AcryTech with UV-15 Colorguard or equal shall be applied to a properly scraped and blown surface at a rate of .04 gallons per square yard per coat. The second coat application should not be made until the 1st coat is thoroughly dry to the touch. AcryTech with UV-15 Colorguard is to be mixed as follows:

AcryTech with UV-15 Colorguard	½ drum
Clean Silica Sand	(200) lbs.
Water	(15-18) gallons

AcryTech Line Paint –

1. Tennis court line paint to be applied in two (2) coats with 2” baselines.
