



COACHING CRITERIA AND BACKGROUND CHECKS

Individual volunteers and/or applicants found to be guilty of the following crimes will be disqualified as a volunteer/applicant as outlined below. The term "guilty" in these criteria means the applicant was found guilty following a trial, entered a guilty plea, entered a "no contest" plea accompanied by the court's finding of guilty, regardless of whether there was a conviction or a withholding of guilt. This policy does not apply to charges that resulted in acquittal, dismissal or in an entry of "nolle prosequi".

1. Any volunteer/applicant is disqualified if said volunteer/applicant was **ever found guilty of**:
 - a) All sex offenses including child molestation, rape, sexual assault, sexual battery, sodomy, prostitution, solicitation, indecent exposure, etc.
 - b) All felony violence including murder, manslaughter, aggravated assault, kidnapping, robbery, aggravated burglary, etc.
2. Any volunteer/applicant is disqualified for service if said volunteer/applicant has been **found guilty within the last 10 years of**:
 - a) All felony offenses other than violence or sex including drug offenses, theft, embezzlement, fraud, child endangerment, etc.
 - b) Multiple misdemeanor drug offenses (more than one), simple drug possession or possession of drug paraphernalia, etc.
3. Any volunteer/applicant will be disqualified for service if said volunteer/applicant has been **found guilty within the last 7 years of**:
 - a) All misdemeanor violence offenses including simple assault, battery, domestic violence, hit and run, etc.
4. Any volunteer/applicant will be disqualified for service if said volunteer/applicant has been **found guilty within the last 5 years of**:
 - a) Any misdemeanor that would be considered a potential danger to children or is directly related to the functions of the volunteer/applicant including contributing to the delinquency of a minor, providing alcohol to a minor, or theft if the volunteer/applicant will be handling money.
5. Any volunteer/applicant will be disqualified if said volunteer/applicant is **found guilty within the last 2 years of**:
 - a) Two misdemeanor DUI charges within a 12-month period.

Should any pending charges described above be uncovered, or should any of the above charges be brought against an applicant/volunteer during the season, the applicant/volunteer will be suspended from serving until such time as the charges have been cleared or dropped and reinstatement approved by the Sports Manager and Parks and Recreation Director.
